

Internet Explorer


1. In Internet Explorer web browser click Tools.




- 2. The internet tools are displayed.
- 3. Click Internet Options.




- 4. The internet options are displayed
- 5. Click Languages.




- 6. The language menu is displayed.

- 13. The language settings have been changed. A new web browser may need to be opened to view TABC: Online web page.




1. In the Chrome web browser click the : button.




- 2. The Chrome options are displayed.
- 3. Click Settings.




- 4. The setting options are displayed.
- 5. Scroll down and click **Show advanced settings**.




- 6. The advanced setting options are displayed.
