



2021 Changes Calendar

JUNE & JULY

- **Submit completed original (new) license applications.**
- **Learn about new proposed fees and TABC 2021 Changes.**
- **TABC sends instruction email to AIMS onboarding Group 1** (manufacturing and distribution tier, brewpubs, and license holders with September and October expiration months).

JULY 31

- **Deadline to submit completed original applications and payment (before TABC's August pause on accepting original applications).**

AUGUST

- **Original application pause is in effect.** TABC will not accept applications for original or subordinate licenses or supplemental changes during August. TABC resumes accepting these applications in AIMS in September.
- **AIMS onboarding education begins** for manufacturing and distribution tiers, brewpubs, and any license holder whose license expires in September or October (regardless of year).
- **TABC sends instruction email to AIMS onboarding Group 2** (license holders with November expiration months).
- **TABC accepts renewals for licenses that expire in August 2021 or before.** License holders with September renewal dates wait until September to renew in AIMS.
- **Pre-Sept. 1 license fees stay in effect.**
- **License holders can apply for temporary event authorizations** for September events using new forms.

SEPTEMBER

- **Alcohol Industry Management System (AIMS) launches.**
- **TABC accepts applications for original and subordinate licenses, supplemental changes and temporary event authorizations in AIMS.**
- **The first phase of industry (manufacturing and distribution tiers and brewpubs) claims their business and onboards into AIMS.**
 - **Any license or permit holder** whose license expires in the month of **September or October (regardless of year)** claims their business, onboards into AIMS and renews their licenses in AIMS.
 - Any license holder who needs to apply for a new original license, subordinate authority, supplemental change of location or ownership/officers, or **temporary event authorization * (see note below)** onboards into AIMS.
- **AIMS onboarding education for Group 2** (license holders with November expiration months regardless of year).
- **TABC sends instruction email to AIMS onboarding Group 3** (license holders with December expiration months).
- **New license and permit structure takes effect.** Existing license and permit holders automatically gain new authorities under their current permit, where applicable.
- **New temporary event authorization process launches.**
- **New fees take effect** for any businesses with a license expiration date of Sept. 1, 2021 or later.
- **Beer and ale are considered malt beverages**, which means updates for:
 - TABC's licensing structure
 - Excise tax reporting and payments
 - Nonresident reporting
 - Product registration
 - Cash and credit law
 - Marketing practices
 - Hours of distribution and sale
 - Transportation and storage
 - Local option elections
 - Warehouse registration

* **Temporary Events Authorizations:** Businesses may use the new PDF forms that will be posted to the TABC website Aug. 1 to submit authorization requests for events happening Sept. 1 or later. Then, once you onboard into AIMS based at your scheduled time, we encourage you to start using AIMS to submit authorization requests for temporary events.
