



Instructions for Primary American Source Letter

When a holder of a Nonresident Brewer's License (BN) applies for product registration with TABC, they must declare that they are the primary American source of supply of the product(s) in the application, as per [Section 63.06 of the Alcoholic Beverage Code](#).

Applicants must upload a document declaring themselves as the Primary American Source with their product registration application in the Alcohol Industry Management System (AIMS). They can upload either TABC's letter template on the next page (preferred) or their own document. View the steps for both options below.

Option 1: TABC template

1. Complete the form fields on the next page.
2. Get the completed form notarized electronically or in person.
3. [Log in to AIMS](#).
4. Go to your product registration application and upload the notarized form to the **Supporting Documents** section.

Option 2: Other document type

You can also upload your declaration using **one** of the following options:

- A separate notarized letter **or**
- An unsworn declaration with the same language stated in [Section 132.001\(d\) of the Civil Practice and Remedies Code](#).

Note: If a document needs to be corrected, it must be notarized again.



Primary American Source Letter with Sworn Declaration

This letter serves as a declaration to the Texas Alcoholic Beverage Commission that the COMPANY NAMED _____ is the primary American source of supply for the BRAND OR PRODUCT NAMED _____ as per Section 63.06(a) of the Texas Alcoholic Beverage Code, which states:

"No holder of a nonresident brewer's license may solicit, accept, or fill an order for malt beverages from a holder of a brewer's or distributor's license unless the nonresident brewer is the primary American source of supply for the brand of malt beverages that is ordered."
